



BENEFITS OF DENTA & OPTIPLUS



DENTAL CARE BENEFITS

The contribution by the CMCM is limited to the benefits for dental care provided for in the official rates.

For the following procedures, the CMCM contributes up to a maximum of 75% of the remaining amount owed by the member after the contributions have been paid by the health insurance provider and the CMCM RÉGIME COMMUN:

DENTAL CARE AND PERIODONTAL TREATMENT

DENTAL CARE

The CMCM covers dental care up to an annual maximum amount of €600 per beneficiary, without exceeding the maximum amount per procedure listed below:

DS5	Metallic brace in parodontosis or fracture of the alveolar ridges	€50
DS6	Prosthetic dental brace or bite guard	€50
DS18	Full reconstitution of a post crown tooth	€30
DS19	Reconstitution of a resin angle on the incisive-canine group	€30
DS33	Gold restoration	€30
DS34	Inlay, one side	€50
DS35	Inlay on two sides of a tooth	€150
DS36	Inlay on three sides or onlay, per tooth	€150

The CMCM contributes to the costs of:

- composite fillings in the amount of €8 per tooth, up to a maximum amount of €40 per calendar year;
- Pulpectomy treatment, up to a maximum amount of €20 per calendar year.

PERIODONTAL TREATMENTS

The CMCM covers the cost of a periodontal treatment up to an annual maximum amount of €200 per beneficiary.

N.B.: Benefits for periodontal treatment combined with benefits for dental care cannot exceed the annual maximum amount of €600 per beneficiary.



ORTHODONTICS

The CMCM covers the costs of the following orthodontic procedures up to an annual maximum amount of €350 per child.

- DT10 Orthodontic mouldings supplied at the till
- DT11 Examination of the position of teeth with mouldings
- DT21 Treatment of the malposition of teeth using different devices before the start of active treatment
- DT22 Treatment of the malposition of teeth by inclined plane of more than two teeth, before the start of active treatment
- DT23 Reduction of the interdental space by ligature or traction
- DT31 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, started before 17 years of age, first period of 6 months, on placement of the device
- DT32 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, started before 17 years of age, first period of 6 months, at the end of this period
- DT33 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, second period of 9 months at the end of this period
- DT34 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, requiring several mouldings and devices by significant asynchronism of evolutionary rates of the teeth and the skeleton, third period in the 21st month of treatment
- DT35 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, requiring several mouldings and devices by significant asynchronism of evolutionary rates of teeth and the skeleton, third period, at the end of active treatment or in the 27th month of treatment
- DT36 Orthodontic treatment, with removable device, for labial or labio-maxillary fissure started before 17 years of age, annual fee, at the end of the annual period

- DT46 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, for labial or labio-maxillary fissure started before 17 years of age, annual fee, at the end of the annual period
- DT61 Bracing of a group of hemiarch teeth after orthodontic treatment
- DT62 Bracing of a complete arch after orthodontic treatment

The CMCM covers the costs for the treatments below up to a maximum amount of €250 per measure.

- DT41 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, started before 17 years of age, first period of 6 months, on placement of the device
- DT42 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, started before 17 years of age, first period of 6 months, at the end of this period
- DT43 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, second period of 9 months at the end of this period
- DT44 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, requiring several mouldings and devices by significant asynchronism of evolutionary rates of teeth and the skeleton, third period, in the 21st month of treatment
- DT45 Orthodontic treatment, with fixed device, requiring several mouldings and devices by significant asynchronism of evolutionary rates of teeth and the skeleton, third period, at the end of active treatment or in the 27th month of treatment

Contrary to Article 7 (1), the CMCM grants a one-time contribution of €350 per beneficiary for orthodontic treatments for members aged 17 and older.

Total reimbursement by CMCM (RÉGIME COMMUN + DENTA & OPTIPLUS):

€366.92 + €1,000.00 = €1,366.92

DENTURES AND IMPLANTS

The CMCM covers the costs for dentures up to an annual maximum amount of €2,500 per beneficiary, however without exceeding the maximum sum of €3,500 over two consecutive years, subject to the maximum limit per procedure listed below:

FIXED DENTURES

Crown, post crown, bridge, Telescopic crown	€400
Inlay, inlay core, hinge	€150

REMOVABLE DENTURES

Removable partial denture (model casting)	€400
Denture, plastic or metal base	€150
Bracket or attachment	€100

OTHER BENEFITS

Maximum amount per procedure	€80
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If the health insurance provider refuses to cover the costs, the reimbursement for the abovementioned procedures is limited to a maximum of 80% of the maximum amounts per procedure.

DENTAL IMPLANTS

The CMCM covers the costs of dental implants up to a maximum amount of €350 per implant and up to an annual maximum amount of €1,400 per beneficiary.

VISUAL AIDS AND REFRACTIVE SURGERY

For the following benefits, the CMCM covers up to 80% of the remaining amount owed by the member after the contributions have been paid by the health insurance provider and the CMCM RÉGIME COMMUN.

GLASSES

CORRECTIVE LENSES

Annual maximum contribution of €100 per beneficiary for the cost of corrective lenses.

FRAMES

Annual maximum contribution of €30 per calendar year for the cost of frames.

CONTACT LENSES

Annual maximum contribution of €100 per beneficiary for the cost of contact lenses.

REFRACTIVE SURGERY

The CMCM contributes to the medical costs for refractive surgery up to a maximum amount of €500 per eye.
